# **COVID-19 Housing Stabilization Fund**



In an effort to help City of Pittsburgh residents maintain stability during the COVID-19 pandemic, the URA has partnered with the Urban League of Greater Pittsburgh to administer the COVID-19 Housing Stabilization Fund.

The fund provides <u>rental</u>, <u>mortgage</u>, <u>and utility assistance</u> to workers who are affected by the outbreak because their hours were cut and/or not able to work given the many circumstances associated with preserving public health and community safety.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

#### **Applicants must:**

- Be a City of Pittsburgh resident
- Be employed, recently employed, or self-employed and experience a reduction in hours or a layoff due to the employer reducing/eliminating work hours; or the loss of contract work as a public health precaution related to the COVID-19 virus (<u>Documentation from the employer will be</u> required.)
- Be experiencing a financial hardship and inability to pay rent, mortgage payment(s), or utilities
